

# Competitive Summary: Carbonite vs. Symantec

Carbonite offers a suite of affordable cloud backup solutions specifically made for small and medium-sized businesses without per-instance fees or per-license fees. Symantec Backup Exec is an enterprise solution where customers pay for the backup license, as well as for each individual agent needed to back up various pieces of infrastructure.

And while Symantec Backup Exec supports cloud backup, Symantec has no cloud storage offering! Carbonite includes cloud storage space in its plans, with the option to add more as a customer's business grows.

## IT Situation

**Two virtualized servers (Hyper-V hypervisor) each having three VMs containing critical files and Microsoft applications, and one physical server containing an Oracle database and file-level data. The total backup size for all is 1.5 TB.**

**Solution:** Carbonite's Server Prime plan is the best choice for this situation, as it backs up an unlimited number of devices and includes 500 GB of cloud storage (with the option to purchase more). Symantec Backup Exec customers would not only have to pay for multiple licenses and options, but cloud storage is not included and would have to be purchased from a third party.
