IT Situation

10 workstations; two virtualized servers (Hyper-V hypervisor) each having two VMs (one containing an SQL database and one containing an Exchange database) and both containing critical files and Microsoft applications; and one physical server that has an active directory database and file-level data. The total backup size for all is 1.5 TB.

Solution: Carbonite's Server Pro Bundle plan is the best choice for this situation, as it backs up an unlimited number of workstations and devices, and includes 500 GB of cloud storage (with the option to purchase more).
